LAWRENCE L. HERMAN, B.A., LL.B., is a graduate of the University of Toronto Law Faculty (1969) and a member of the Saskatchewan and Ontario bars.

He served in the Canadian foreign service in the 1970's in a variety of posts, at the United Nations in Geneva and in Ottawa, representing Canada in numerous international conferences and meetings, including the GATT, IMO, OECD and the UN Conference on the Law of the Sea. Prior leaving the foreign service in 1980, Mr. Herman was the head of the Economic and Treaty Law Section of the Legal Bureau in the External Affairs Department.

In his law practice, Mr. Herman concentrates on international trade and international business transactions. He has acted for private sector clients and governments and international agencies in the trade area, dealing particularly with the GATT/WTO, FTA and NAFTA and appears as counsel before dispute-resolution bodies under the NAFTA, as well as before the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, the courts and in Parliamentary committees.

Mr. Herman has been listed as one of Canada's 500 top legal counsel by the LEXPERT, a leading professional publication.

Mr. Herman was a member of the Canadian government's International Trade Advisory Committee (ITAC) Task Force on Trade Policy in 1996-1998. In 1998, he was appointed to the Federal Government's Ad Hoc Advisory Group on Investment Issues. In 1999, he was named by Canada to the Dispute Settlement Roster of Panelists at the World Trade Organization in Geneva.

Mr. Herman has served on the Council of the Section on Energy and Resources Law of the International Bar Association. Currently, he is Chair of the Trade Policy Committee of the Alliance of Canadian Manufacturers and Exporters and is a member of the Advisory Board of the Canada-U.S. Law Institute, the International Affairs Committee of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce, the C.D. Howe Institute; and several other business and government trade policy organizations.

Lawrence Herman also teaches international trade in Osgoode Hall Law School's graduate law (LL.M.) program. He was an op-ed columnist on international trade and business for the Financial Post (Toronto) from 1993 to 1998 and is a frequent commentator on trade on ROBTV and CTV's NewsNet. His book, *Canadian Trade Remedy Law & Practice*, was published in 1997.
